Grading Policies:

You are graded on your performance. Your performance includes class assignments and other assigned performance tasks. IEP mastery is always a major consideration. When considering IEP objectives, the objectives worked on during the current 9 weeks are considered. If there is more than 1 objective in a subject/domain, each objective is assigned a grade and averaged together for the overall subject/domain grade.

- ELA- this is your Functional Academic grade for ELA, math, science, and social studies
- Mathematics- this is your Prevocational grade
- Science –this is your Daily Living grade
- Social Studies- this is your Community grade
- Reading- this is your Recreation/Leisure grade
- 90-100 -Mastery of IEP objectives or task currently working on during the current 9 weeks
- 80-89 –making good progress, or effort, on IEP objectives or task currently working on during the current 9 weeks
- 75-79 –making adequate progress, or effort, on achieving IEP objectives or task currently working on during the current 9 weeks
- 70-74 –making little progress, or effort, on IEP objectives or task currently working on during the current 9 weeks
- 69-65 -refusal to do work
