

### MEDICAID, FOOD STAMPS, AND TANF DURING *COVID-19*

#### **MEDICAID**

- DFCS will waive verification requirements like check stubs and bank statements
- Renewals due in March and April are automatically continued four (4) months
- Those applying for Nursing Home Medicaid with income over the Medicaid income limits (CAP) require a Qualified Income Trust (QIT). This requirement will be waived during the crisis. You can qualify for Medicaid even if you don't have a QIT signed before you apply. (Ask that DFCS waive all requirements you can't complete because of your disability)

#### FOOD STAMPS/SNAP

- Renewals due in March, April, and May are extended six (6) months
- Pandemic SNAP (P-SNAP) All households will get the maximum benefit for your household size for March and April for many this will be an increase in benefits
- Able Bodied Adults Without Dependents (ABAWD) no work requirements
- There are no ABAWD time limits
- Interview and income verification requirements will be waived

#### TANF

• Renewals due in March, April, and May are automatically extended six (6) months

## **HOW DO I APPLY FOR BENEFITS?**

- DFCS offices are closed to the public

# HOW CAN GLSP HELP ME? CALL US IF:

- Your Medicaid benefits were terminated in March or April for not completing a review
- Your Food Stamps or TANF benefits were terminated in March, April, or May for not completing a review
- You are an ABAWD (Able Bodied Adult Without Dependents) and your food stamps are terminated for not working or because of a time limit
- You believe you have been terminated or denied benefits in error
- You are disabled and cannot complete a review or application due to your disability
