



The Reagan Presidency (R) 1980-1988

- Conservative politics returns Goldwater, Nixon, Reagan
- Candidate Reagan background, outsider status
- Domestic Agenda The "New" Right
- the "Moral Majority" Christian coalition of far right conservatives, return of religious fundamentalism to politics
- Reaganomics supply side economics
- tax breaks for the wealthy and big business –
 to create jobs and increase supply, "trickle

- Sharply lower marginal tax rates for individuals and corporations

-) Lack of concern about budget deficits







WASHINGTON — Osama bin Laden, the mastermind of the most devastating attack on American soil in modern times and the most hunted man in the world, was killed in a firefight with United States forces in Pakistan on Sunday, President Obama announced.


In a dramatic late-night appearance in the East Room of the White House, Mr. Obama deelared that "justice has been done" as he disclosed that American military and CLA, operatives had finally cornered Mr. bin Ladox, the Al Qeeds keeder who had clusted them for nearly a deade, and shot him to death at a compound in Pakistan.


