The mission of Warren Road Elementary School is to lay the foundation for our students' lifelong learning by providing opportunities for them to grow academically, physically, artistically, socially, and emotionally in a nurturing, yet challenging environment .

Our Story:

Established in 1970, Warren Road is a public school with an Arts Infusion program within the Richmond County School System. Historically, Warren Road was a neighborhood school serving students from nearby neighborhoods. In efforts to increase enrollment and participation in the arts, in 2009, Warren Road piloted an arts program. Currently, Warren Road serves over 570 students in grades PreK-5, 10% of which are Arts Infusion students. Admittance into the Arts Infusion Program is based on prior academic criteria, good character/behavior, and district preference. Many students attending Warren Road go on to further their education in Richmond County Magnet Schools. Warren Road is located in Augusta which is the second largest and oldest city in Georgia. Augusta is best known as the Garden City and home of the Masters Golf Tournament. RCSS operates 56 schools and serves over 30,000 students. RCSS has International Baccalaureate Program, top-rated magnet schools and programs, specialized curricula such as STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics), Arts infusion, and technology-rich classrooms.

Our CCRPI stats:

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in five main categories, for a total of 100 possible points. In 2019-2020, statewide accountability was suspended due to COVID-19 closures.
