



# First Grade Supply List

Welcome to First Grade!!! The following supply items will be needed this upcoming school year. Please read over the items carefully. Some items will need to be labeled with your child's name, while others may not. We appreciate your help in providing these necessary items to ensure a successful school year! We look forward to meeting you and beginning this new journey!

We request a payment of **\$4.00** to cover the cost of your child's homework binder and tabs.

**LABEL** items "a-f" with your child's **first and last name**.

- a. **Backpack** (please label your child's backpack, lunchbox and other personal belongings before sending them to school).
- b. **4** composition notebooks (ex. Black and white marbled notebooks).
- c. **2** plastic or vinyl folders with pockets and brads.
- d. **1** pair of child's scissors
- e. **1 set of HEADPHONES** for use in the computer lab (please label these with your child's name and store in a Ziploc bag, also labeled with your child's name. We ask that you **DO NOT** purchase EAR BUDS!!! The younger students have trouble keeping them in and they break and tangle easily. A basic pair of headphones is truly the best buy).

**DO NOT LABEL** items "f-r". These will be used by everyone in the classroom.

- f. **4** boxes of 24 count Crayola crayons
- g. **8** glue sticks
- h. **4** packs of pencil top erasers
- i. **4** packs of #2 pencils (If available, Ticonderoga pencils are great to have in the classroom. They sharpen easily and last longer).
- j. **1** pack of 4 count EXPO dry erase markers.
- k. **2** boxes of Kleenex.
- l. Hand sanitizer
- m. **1** box of band aids
- n. **1** roll of paper towels
- o. Clorox wipes
- p. **1** reem of copy paper.
- q. **BOYS: quart size Ziploc bags.**
- r. **GIRLS: gallon size Ziploc bags.**
