Supply List Notes

Hello Parents.

Please help your students take the following steps to prepare their supplies for the first day of school. Please do not write names on the notebooks and folders. **We will label all folders and notebooks with pre-made labels in class.**

--**White Binders**: Please do not put names on the white 2-inch binders. Remove and dispose of the paper from the outer clear plastic covering of the binder.

--**Dividers**: Remove and dispose of the plastic covering around the dividers. Place the dividers in the rings of the white binder. We will need 6 dividers: ELA, math, science, social studies, test prep, and 4H/Champs. If you do not have 6 dividers, it's OK. We may have extra in class.

--**Document Protectors**: Place at least 6 document protectors behind each divider in the binder. If you have more protectors, place more behind each divider. Extras can be placed at the back of the white binder.

--**Ruled Notebook Paper**: Place about 30 sheets of paper in the rings at the very back of the white binder. Please keep the other packs of paper at home. Students will need them.

--**Pencil Pouch**: Place 1 pack of pencils in the pouch (place the other pack in an extra gallon bag).

Place 2 highlighters in the same pouch as the pencils (place any extra in the extra gallon bag).

Place 1 boxed pack of colored pencils in the same pouch as the pencils (Place any extra packs in the extra gallon bag).

Place the pencil sharpener (remove from the package) in a sandwich baggie then in the pouch with the pencils.

Place box of markers in the same pouch as the pencils.

Place 1 set of sticky notes in the pouch with the pencils. (Place any extra packs in the extra gallon bag.)

****Keep the gallon bag of extra supplies at home until the student needs them.

--Folders and Spiral Notebooks:

Place a blue folder inside of a 5-subject spiral notebook. (Math)

Place a green folder inside of a 5-subject spiral notebook. (ELA)

Place 1 purple folder in the rings at the front of the white binder. (Morning Work)

Place 1 red folder in the rings at the front of the white binder. (Spanish)

Bring the one-1 subject composition notebook to class. (ELA)

Bring the two-1subject spiral notebooks to class. (Science and Intervention)

****If you do not have 5 subject spiral notebooks, students will need 2 spiral notebooks each for math and for ELA.

--**Dry Erase Markers, Small White Board, Headphones/Earbuds, Clipboards, Book Covers**: Bring to class as is.
