2023-2024 District Goals

Goal 1: During the 2023- 24 school year we will utilize technology and Richmond County school system Instructional Framework to increase academic achievement across all tested content areas by 3%.

Goal 2: During the 2023-24 school year through our Induction Support Program, we will increase the percentage of highly effective teachers and leaders retained in the Richmond County School System by 3%.
