The Principal's Report was discussed by Mrs. Fry

**\*STEAM Update-** Goshen was not able to receive their **STEAM** certification this year from the **GA Doe**. The faculty and staff will work hard and use the suggestions to participate in the certification process for the 2019-2020, school year. Two areas the faculty and staff will work towards improving will be collaboration and integration of the arts more effectively into the curriculum. **Arts Now** and **Westobou** continue to be supporters and great resources.

**\*i-Ready Mid-year Data-** Testing is almost complete for Diagnostic 2. We have 4 students to complete this task. Reports and data will be shared with parents.

**\*Title I-** There is an on campus meeting with the Title I contact person for our school scheduled for February 25, 2019. At this time, updates and reviews of school goals and on-site tasks will be discussed. Paper work and reports will be completed. Mrs. Fry is working on purchasing the Title I items from this year's budget.

**\*100<sup>th</sup> Day of School** was January 22, 2019. Students and staff participated in 100 day activities incorporating art and math into the daily lessons. The highlight was seeing all of the personal designed t-shirts and hats celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> day.

**\*STEM Camp** for Fifth Graders- On February 11 and 12, 2019, Goshen students will participate in STEM activities such as Coding and making musical instruments. This will be held in the school gymnasium.

**\*Wax Museum-** February 22, 2019, Goshen will present their Wax Museum. This year's highlights will be focused on spotlighting African American Artists. Each grade level will celebrate Black History Month by encouraging art, design, and background information on their chosen artist. The day will begin at 9:30 a.m. with an informative meeting for parents on the upcoming **GA Milestones Test (GMAS)**. Following the meeting there will be two performances spotlighting the students and their work. This will be open to our parents, school council members, and the public to enjoy.

**\*GMAS Preparation.** Along with the parent meeting on February 22, 2019, teachers, administration and staff are preparing the students with daily activities and support. Resources and practice information is available on the Goshen website for parents and students to use.

**\*Member Comments and Concerns-** One of the members wanted to see more encouragement in the area of public speaking, oratory, seeing students participate in speeches and simply bring back the art of conversation. Suggestions were made to give students opportunities and practice.
