One goal currently set for our school is that we will have all units be transdisciplinary on every grade level. The dates of our first IB evaluation was announced. - Dr. Driggers gave a Principal's report on the current status of our school in regards to CCRPI where LFH currently has an 84.2 CCRPI score. Dr. Driggers brought up a pride point when looking at LFH and magnet school attendees. 43 out of 88 students in the 2015-2016 fifth grade class now attend magnet schools. 27 of the 43 fifth grade students attended LFH since Kindergarten.
