Recent discipline data for first semester show 175 out of school suspension days

involving 41 students. Suspensions have increased since last year, but the PBS plan is being used more regularly across many grade levels. Series of consequences in place before a discipline referral to the office. Should deter problem behavior and better involve parents in the process.

Attendance data- reviewed pyramid of interventions for absences. APs and guidance counselors are making frequent phone calls, sending letters home reminding parents of the policy, and involving our school social worker in monthly meetings.

We are defining and refining our processes. Shared process for dismissal and school visitors. More refines are coming as staff or parents identify needs.
