This school year each student at Murphey Middle School will check out a consumable math textbook and an English Language Arts textbook. The consumable math textbook will not be used next year for other students. Your Student will write in this textbook and tear out pages at his/her teacher's request and discard the remaining shell at the end of the school year. If your child loses either textbook, charges will be assessed. In addition, for all damages to the English Language Arts textbook, there will be a fee charged up to a complete replacement.

In an effort to reduce additional textbook loses and charges, Murphey Middle School has decided to issue classroom sets of textbooks for social studies and science. Our decision to issue classroom sets for these textbooks is a result of increasing lost textbooks, the rising cost of textbook replacements, and the hardship it places on families. Library books are still available for checkout on a continuous basis to each and every student. Please note that charges may still be assessed for lost and damaged library books.

If you would still like for your student to checkout a social studies and science textbook in addition to the consumable math textbook and English Language Arts textbook, please contact the school. We will be happy to check out these textbooks in your student's name. The cost for each textbook range from \$50.00 - \$75.00 depending on the existing condition.
