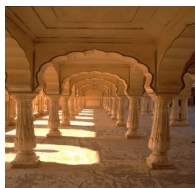


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What is the IBCP?

The International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme (IBCP) is an exciting, new addition to the programs of study offered at ARC! The IBCP couples recognized IB academic rigor with **career preparation, service learning, and reflective, personal growth**. It is a two-year course of study in which students engage in an accredited pathway of career study, take at least two IB courses, and immerse themselves in

What is the Diploma Programme?

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (DP) is a two-year course of study that is globally recognized for its rigor and depth. It not only helps students develop a strong academic base for college, it empowers students to become well-rounded, reflective, life-long learners. Students will take 6 subjects along with the DP Core: Extended Essay; Creativity, Activity, & Service, and Theory of Knowledge.

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When do I take IB?

The Diploma and Career-related Programmes are two-year programs of study that take place during a student's 11th and 12th grade years. During the first two years of high school, students will take prerequisite honors courses and career pathway electives. These classes help fulfill Georgia's graduation requirements, and they deeply prepare students for the challenges of the IB curriculum.

Programme Requirements

IBCP Requirements:

- Take at least two IB courses, one of which lasts for two years
- Complete a Career-related Study

Complete the IBCP Core...

- Take **Personal and Professional Skills**
- Engage in 50 hours of **Service Learning**
- Independently plan and study a 50 hour course of **Language Development**
- Produce an ethical dilemma-based **Reflective Project**

Career-related Study (CRS) Pathways
