The award will consist of a diploma certificate to be presented publicly and a scholarship of One Thousand Dollars (\$ 1000.00) to the student's chosen college or university.

Eligibility Standards:

Principal Criteria:

- 1. *High Academic Achievement*: Outstanding grade point average for the high school years, and class standing in the top 10 percent of all Academy students.
- Excellent Leadership. Demonstrated leadership in classroom, extra-curricular, volunteer, or work activities
 with emphasis on excellence in leadership. These activities may be sponsored by school, church,
 community, or business organizations; or may consist of entrepreneurial undertakings initiated by the
 student. These activities may include but are not limited to the Creativity, Action, and Service (CAS)
 projects required by the International Baccalaureate program.
- 3. *Recommendation of the Dean*. Certification of the Dean of the International Baccalaureate World School Program that the student meets the stated criteria for this award and is otherwise a worthy recipient.

Secondary Criteria:

- 1. College Bound. Stated intentions of the student to attend an institution of higher learning after graduation.
- 2. Writing Skills. Quality of writing sample from an essay on a specified topic.
- 3. Career Plans. Stated career aspirations, if known at this time.
- 4. Hobbies. The nature of outside interests that contribute to a well-rounded individual character.
- 5. *Character and Appearance*. Exhibition of a general character and personal appearance that sets a good example of a leader for other students to emulate.
- 6. Not a Parent. Not having been a parent, nor immediately expecting to be one.
- 7. Scholastic Aptitude Test. Score on college entrance examination tests, to be employed as a tie-breaker.
- 8. *Other considerations*. Any other consideration not covered above that may support or modify the qualifications of the student.

Determination and Presentation Procedures:

- 1. Completion of application form by student.
- 2. Screening of applications by International Baccalaureate and/or Academy educators to result in between two and five primary candidates.
- 3. Selection by the Trustees of the Academy.
- 4. Presentation of a diploma certificate at the Academy awards ceremony.
- 5. Sending scholarship check to the Board of Education for transmittal to the student's selected college or university.
