The City of Augusta's Information Technology Department is excited to sponsor its 2nd Cyber & Robotics Summer Camp. The camp is open to upcoming 6<sup>th</sup> graders through 8<sup>th</sup> graders who are residents of Richmond County.

The Cyber & Robotics Camp will be held in two sessions. Each session runs for two weeks with the first week focusing on Cyber and Security and the second week focusing on Robotics: Session One will run June 17<sup>th</sup> through June 28<sup>nd</sup> and Session Two will run July 15<sup>th</sup> through July 26<sup>th</sup>. The Cyber & Robotics Camp will be held in the Augusta Municipal Building at 535 Telfair Street, Augusta, GA 30901.
