Program Description: The purpose of the Pine Hill Middle School After School Academy is to help students learn and grow both in areas of need and enrichment.



Academics: Student learning opportunities will include USATestPrep, I-Ready, FEV Tutor, Nearpod, and missing assignments.



Discipline Policy: The discipline policy of the Richmond County School System will be obeyed. **Positive Behavior Intervention Strategies (PBIS)** will be followed. Students will be allowed a maximum of three reflection periods during the After School Academy. Pine Hill is a **No Bullying Zone!**

Dress Code: The Richmond County School System and Pine Hill Middle School Dress Codes must be followed. There should be no hats, hoods, or Air Pods in the building. Cell phones are allowed but should not be visible, used, or displayed during the instructional day.

Attendance: Monday – Wednesday, 4:15 – 6:15 pm, beginning **Monday, November 8, 2021**. Families must provide their own transportation, and students must be picked up by 6:15 pm daily in the front of the school. Students must have regular attendance to continue attending the After School Academy.

Snack: A light afternoon snack will be provided for students each day.



Safety Protocols: Masks are required at all times at school. Hand washing and sanitizing are required, and students should practice social distancing when possible. Students must bring their own water bottles, as there are only bottle-filling stations available in the school.
