Phonological Awareness

Cheer for Rhymes: Say each pair of words, ask your child to cheer if they rhyme.

Pox / Socks Sick / Sad Nose / Blows Spots / Knots

Literacy

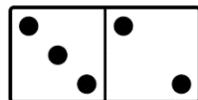
Story Time: [Goldilocks Has Chicken Pox](#)

Oh no! Goldilocks has chicken pox! Who will take care of her?
How will she get better? Help your child make real-world connections.
Who takes care of you when you are sick?

Math

Domino Dots: using dominoes (real or homemade),
have your child count the dots on each domino and tell how many.
To make it harder, turn each domino into an addition problem.

For example:



3 dots on the left and 2 dots on the right
 $3 + 2 = 5$

Writing

Talk with your child about all the people who can help when others are sick (community workers, family members, etc.). Have your child draw a picture of one of the helpers and dictate to you how they help.
