As we start a new year and new semester, a sense of renewal ushers in! A renewal of purpose and collective commitment to excellence in teaching and learning. With this comes the firm resolution to achieve desired academic results. During second semester, Tutt will be offering additional opportunities to students to work on reading and math skills by participating in an extended learning day referred to as the "Sunrise Academy."

The Sunrise Academy will be held on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays each week (7:30 a.m.-8:30 a.m.), beginning on Tuesday, February 5th. The Sunrise Academy will end on March 28th.
