

What is the Augusta Museum of History Teen Council?

AMH's Teen Council is a committee of 10-12 high school aged students from Richmond County who represent the museum's teen audience. Members develop creative programming and coordinate community events. The task force will meet once or twice a month during the school year (August-May).

What are the goals and duties of the Council?

- Plan, support, and promote teen initiatives at the at the Augusta Museum of History
- Design and execute one project, targeted at teens, that will be made available to the museum's audience at large.
- Attend monthly meetings, and participate in lectures, group discussions, workshops and leadership training
- Serve as volunteers assisting with museum classes, public events and community programs
- Explore the professional roles and functions of various museum departments

Who should apply?

You should apply if you:

- Will be a high school student during the 2018-2019 school year, **high school** aged home school students are also encouraged to apply
- Are interested in history and museum careers
- Are highly motivated and passionate about museums and developing community projects
- Can commit to monthly meetings during the school year, and assisting with occasional special events

The Augusta Museum of History is looking for dedicated, enthusiastic, creative high school students to become a part of our museum. Applicants must be high school students enrolled for the 2019-2020 school year. Applications are accepted based on merit, including writing abilities, and completeness of application. Applications must be submitted by **July 15, 2019** to be considered.
