#### Requirements for Application

1. The applicant must be a graduating Senior at The Academy of Richmond County in good overall standing.
2. The applicant must be in pursuit of HIGHER EDUCATION at a TRADE SCHOOL, TECHNICAL COLLEGE, TWO- OR FOUR-YEAR COLLEGE or UNIVERSITY.
3. The applicant must a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 on a 4.0 scale at the end of the Fall semester of senior year.
4. The applicant must have applied and received acceptance to a post-secondary institution by Fall 2023.
5. The applicant must submit the application via google form. Which includes uploading a 250-300 word essay, Resume (optional), 2 references and a copy of the transcript.
6. **APPLICATIONS MUST BE TURN IN NO LATER THAN MARCH 23,2023 MID-NIGHT**

#### General Instructions

Before submitting the google form application you will need to prepare the following information and have it ready to upload.

1. Write your 250-300 essay. **The essay should address how the 80's Decade Scholarship will contribute to the future achievements of your educational and career goals.** You will be required to upload your essay into the google form.
2. A Resume is optional. If you feel your Resume will help you to stand out and give us additional information about you. You may upload it.
3. You will need the name, phone number and email address of 2 references that we can contact on your behalf.
4. A copy of your Fall 2022 Transcript. It must show your GPA
