Any IB student who fails a non-IB semester or year-long class MUST make it up during summer school. Actual IB classes are not available to be made up in summer school. Failing an IB class or not making up a failed non-IB class in summer school will result in dismissal from the IB Programme.

IB scores will be available on July 6 <u>here</u>. Mr. Guinn gave everyone their personal code and PIN this spring. Keep that in a smart place because you will need it to access the scores.
