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AP Exams

CollegeBoard has changed the AP Exam ordering process this year two ways: Firstly, we have to place our order by November 4th in order for a test to arrive in May which seems crazy but they maintain that students perform better when they have committed to taking to the exam early. Secondly, students must have joined their AP class online on AP Central in order to get the test. If they are not in the class on AP Central, an exam WILL NOT come for them. There is no way to override the process and order a test if they have not logged in and entered the join code for their class. Please check with your child and verify that they are in the class on AP Central. Additionally, if a student orders a test and does not take it, the student will be charged for the test. As a part of our NMSI grant, all students in NMSI courses (math, science, English, and computer sciences) are REQUIRED to take the AP Exam. We met with the juniors and seniors on Monday to have them look at exam conflicts with AP and IB. We asked that they complete this survey.
