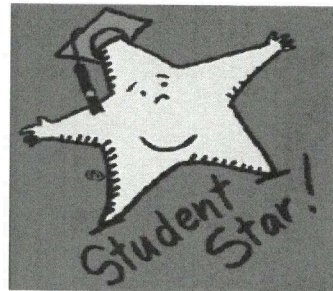
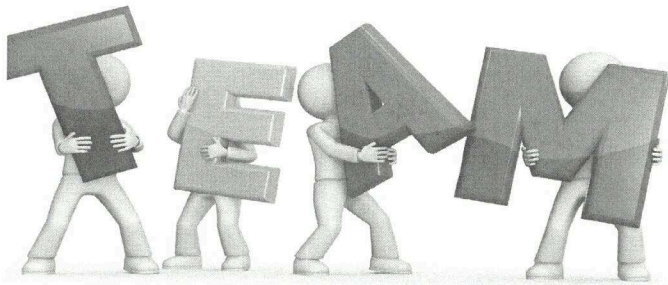

**Course Description and Objectives** -Sixth grade intervention is a **support course** designed to help students improve in the subject areas in which they are struggling and/or challenge them with new materials. Emphasis will be placed on reading comprehension strategies and math to assist in meeting grade level expectations.



**Resource Variety:** iReady, Canvas, Coach, and computers. Students will be given incentives/rewards for progress/growth.

### Intervention Strategies

1. Monitoring Progress Frequently
2. Providing Feedback
3. Student Reflection (Students will learn about self and how they learn. Students will be able to identify errors and make corrections.)

**Progress: Student progress will be assessed biweekly.**

**Assignments and Absences** - Students will develop study skill strategies and practice study skills to prepare for their class assessments (Math, Science, Social Studies, ELA). Students will complete make-up assignments from their classes. Students will also receive a variety of support assignments to possibly improve grade/growth in their subject courses.
