## 6th Grade Intervention Course Syllabus 2020-2021



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**Course Description and Objectives -**Sixth grade intervention is a **support course** designed to help students improve in the subject areas in which they are struggling and/or challenge them with new materials. ## Progress: Student progress will be assessed biweekly.

Assignments and Absences - Students will develop study skill strategies and practice study skills to prepare for their class assessments (Math, Science, Social Studies, ELA). Students will complete make-up assignments from their classes. Students will also receive a variety of support assignments to possibly improve grade/growth in their subject courses.
