- Determine eligibility, requirements and timeline for your institution of choice.



 Dual Enrollment is a program that provides funding for students at eligible high schools that are enrolled to take approved college-level coursework for credit towards both high school and college graduation requirements.



- Apply for your institution of choice and complete the required entrance testing (ACT, SAT, or Accuplacer) by established deadline.
- Complete the online Dual Enrollment Funding Application.





- Meet with your institution
 Dual-Enrollment Specialist to
 sign-up for courses and
 discuss your plan of action.
- Be sure NOT to schedule Dual-Enrollment courses during mandatory High School courses/times.



 Complete the Dual Enrollment Student Participation Agreement with your parent and school counselor.



- Once enrolled in your Dual-Enrollment course(s) print a copy of your schedule and submit to your school counselor.
- Your high school schedule will be updated to reflect your dual-enrollment courses.
