<p>ABC Order</p> <p>Write words in alphabetical order.</p>	<p>Red & Blue Words</p> <p>Write your words with red vowels and blue consonants.</p>	<p>Rhyming Words</p> <p>Write each word and then a rhyming word next to it.</p>
<p>Math Words</p> <p>vowel = 5 consonant = 10</p> <p>Write a number sentence for each word and solve. ex: cat $10 + 5 + 10 = 25$</p>	<p>Free Words</p> <p>Write your words any way you choose.</p>	<p>Art Words</p> <p>Draw a picture to match your spelling words.</p> 
<p>Rainbow Words</p> <p>Write your words with rainbow letters.</p>	<p>Waterfall Words</p> <p>ex: cat c ca cat</p>	<p>Silly Words</p> <p>Write a silly sentence for each word.</p>

<p>What's Your Opinion?</p> <p>Explain why you enjoyed the text. or Explain why you did not enjoy the text.</p>	<p>Free</p> <p>You don't have to do anything. Just enjoy reading!</p>	<p>Be the Author</p> <p>If you could change a part of the story, what would happen?</p>
<p>Who's the Star?</p> <p>Identify & describe the main character.</p>	<p>Problem & Solution</p> <p>What was the big problem in your text? How was the problem solved?</p>	<p>Make a Connection</p> <p>Explain how your text connects to a different text you read.</p>
