Exemptions

- Students may be exempted from the teacher-created exam if they meet the following qualifications:
- 90% average or above in the course. (Note: No attendance requirements to meet-Attendance was removed as a part of IHA-R.)
- Students should have returned exemption letters signed by teacher and parents on last **Friday, December 12th** in the front office.

Grading

• The teacher-created exam will count as 10% of the final grade.

Attendance

- Students who exempt their final exams will be marked with the EXM attendance code.
- If students don't take an exam, a zero (0) in the exam column will be entered.
- Students will take exams during their designated class period only. If a student arrives after the exam period starts, they are not permitted to enter the testing session, they should report to the main office and will have to take the exam during the make-up time.
- Make-Up exams will be Paper-based Exams ONLY.

- Students whose parents permit them to leave after the exam due to Exam Exemption, must sign out in the main office for verification of signatures.
- Students will not be released from class during the exam period. Once the exam period begins, students will remain in their testing site until dismissed.
- No cell phones, movies, or any other disruption in the testing environment even when finished. Students may quietly read a book.

School Hours:

- 7:25 AM 2:15 PM
- Students are allowed to enter the building starting at 7:00 AM for breakfast in the cafeteria. Breakfast entries after 7:15 AM are for late buses only.
- Students should not be dropped off earlier than 6:50 AM; due to no supervising staff until 7:00 AM
- Students will not be dismissed early after 1:45 PM.
- During afternoon dismissal, students are expected to clear the building or report to their extracurricular activity, teacher for tutoring, etc., by 2:25 PM.

Attendance & Grades: Parents/Guardians can keep track of student's academic progress and attendance by visiting the Parent Portal via Infinite Campus.

Absences: Students absent due to illness must submit a doctor's note upon return. Parents/Guardians can submit up to 5 written notes per year to excuse absences. All excuses should go to Ms. Saulsberry, Attendance & Discipline Secretary, in the front office. Tardies cannot be excused by parents. Frequent absences may result in a SWARM Referral to the social worker. Daily attendance is essential!

Assignments: To keep track of students' learning objectives and determine assignments due when absent from school for any reason, visit the teacher's Class page and view the Week at a Glance (WAG). From WHS website (http://westside.rcboe.org/), see Staff & Departments, then click on the teacher's name.

Communication: Encourage ALL parents to stay connected by joining the teacher's class Remind account. Visit the Teacher's class page for sign-up details. Also, visit Westside's Webpage (https://www.rcboe.org/westside) and read the "Ways to Stay Connected with Westside High School" box. Be sure to periodically review Westside High School's main page for upcoming events/activities, as well as student highlights!

Dress Code: This is a reminder that all students are expected to follow the dress code guidelines. Hoods, leggings worn as pants, biker shorts, crop tops, short skirts, see-through clothing, pajamas, and similar items are not permitted (see posters around building). Edgenuity: Students scheduled for Edgenuity classes will not see a grade during progress report periods because the class is still in progress. It is important for parents to monitor student progress by reviewing the percentage complete. Students must complete 100 percent of the course (PERCENTAGE COMPLETE) and pass with a 70 percent or higher (OVERALL GRADE) in order to get credit for the class. Once the class is completed, the student must notify their school counselor to get the class added to their transcript for credit.

Immunization Records: Parent/Guardian(s) of 11th Grade Students who are missing immunizations (specifically the MCV4) will receive information from Nurse Gilmer regarding the missing immunization. It is vital for this to be taken care of as soon as possible. Failure to follow mandatory immunizations could result in your student being withdrawn from school. If you choose not to vaccinate, there is an affidavit that you can complete and have notarized. This form can be obtained from Nurse Gilmer. All immunizations or waivers must be completed as soon as possible and turned into the nurse. Lunch: Lunch is provided for all students at no cost. Students are **not** allowed to leave campus for lunch nor are they allowed to have any outside food delivered to the school.

Metal Detectors: At Westside High School, the safety and well-being of our students, staff, and visitors remain our top priority. As part of our continued efforts to maintain a secure learning environment, we will soon implement the use of metal detectors at certain entry points within the school. All students and visitors will be required to enter through the metal detectors upon arrival. To ensure a smooth and efficient screening process, students should remove their laptops and/or iPads from their personal belongings before passing through the detectors. Additionally, please be aware that student's personal belongings may be subject to search during this process. Your support is essential in helping us maintain a school community where students can focus on learning without concerns about safety.

Conditions may include Asthma (requiring inhalers), severe allergies (requiring Epi-Pen), Diabetes, Seizures, Sickle-Cell, etc. Remember, absolutely no students are allowed to carry any

medications without prior authorization.

School Purchases: Many purchases within Westside will be cashless transactions. Students will need to create an account on MySchool Bucks to pay for certain items such as lockers and parking permits. Senior Early Release: This is a reminder to ALL seniors, who are on Senior Early Release, are expected to leave campus immediately after their last class. Students are not permitted to remain on campus. Failure to abide by these expectations could result in the Senior Early Release privilege being taken away for the identified senior.

Sporting Event Dates: To see the most current game schedules and scores, please visit www. rcboe.org, click on Staff and Departments, click on Athletics, then click on weekly schedules and scores. Be sure to visit Westside's Website for opportunities to purchase gear to wear to sporting events!

Student Absences: Students absent due to illness must submit a doctor's note upon return. Parents/Guardians can submit up to 5 written notes per year to excuse absences. All excuses should go to Ms. Saulsberry, Attendance & Discipline Secretary, in the front office. Tardies cannot be excused by parents. Frequent absences may result in a SWARM Referral to the social worker. Daily attendance is essential!

Student Drivers: Reminder students who drive must submit a signed Permit Form (from Secretary Mrs. Blume) in the main office, Driver's License copy, Proof of Insurance, and \$15 fee. Approved permits should be displayed in the rearview mirror or dashboard. Parking is only allowed in the student parking lot near the black box theater. Unauthorized parking or lack of a permit may result in towing, with random checks by the school resource officer.

Tardies: It is imperative that students report to class on time daily. Students have approximately 5 minutes to transition from each class. Students who accumulate excessive tardies will face disciplinary action and revocation of extracurricular activities.

Technology Policy: Parents and students, review the new code of conduct Rule 16, pertaining to cell phones, cell phone confiscation, and disciplinary action. No cell phones or devices are allowed in classrooms, hallways, or gymnasiums. Students' phones will remain invisible at Westside from Intake Bell to Dismissal Bell.
