What We Are Learning Right Now :

ELA: We are using the Foundations program to help students become stronger readers. This is the first time the program has been used in 3rd grade. Please see the Unit 1 letter. We are also reading the classic book Charlotte's Web.

Math: Students are working on the addition and subtraction of 3-digit numbers. If students are not yet fluent with basic facts, they will need to practice.

Social Studies: Our focus is on map skills. Students have a world map in their binders .and they need to be able to identify and label all continents and oceans.

Science: We will be learning about rocks, soil, and fossils.
