# READING

This summer all rising 5th graders must read *Hatchet* by Gary Paulsen.

### Activity:

Students are required to read *Hatchet* by Gary Paulsen. Once the novel is complete, students must create a trading card based on the main character from the story, using the Trading Card Creator tool found at:

If you are unable to access this site you may create your own character trading card. Please make sure the following components are present:

- Description of the character
- Insight (thoughts/feelings)
- Development (problem/goal/outcome)
- Memorable Interactions (quote/actions)
- Personal Connections (How do you relate to this person?)

Feel free to be creative and add additional images or information to your card.

### Rubric

Trading Card Rubric – You must check the site above to locate the components.

### **Novel Character Information**

- 2   Trading card has name and picture of a main character from the novel.
- 1   Trading card is missing name or picture of a main character from the novel.

### **Trading Card Components**

- 5   Card is formatted correctly with 5 components.
- 4   Card is formatted with 4 components.
- 3   Card is formatted with 3 components.
- 2   Card is formatted with 2 components.
- 1   Card is formatted with 1 component.

### **Grammar & spelling (conventions)**

- 3   Writer makes no errors in grammar or spelling.
- 2   Writer makes 1-3 errors in grammar and/or spelling.
- 1   Writer makes more than 4 errors in grammar and/or spelling.

Students should bring in a two minute student made timed practice test for **each** of the facts (3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12). Tests should be signed and graded by the parents to verify that students have mastered these facts.
