- April 25: 3rd - 8th Math (to include all 8th Grade Algebra C&C Students)
- April 28: 8th - Algebra (Only students scheduled in an 8th Grade Algebra C&C)
- April 29: 5th & 8th - Science (8th grade students enrolled in Physical Science will take the end of grade Physical Science assessment)
