Dear Richmond County School System Families:

Your child is scheduled to take the Georgia Milestones Test on April 22 – April 30, 2025. The test is used to help teachers, students and parents understand what a student has learned and identify where students may need extra help and learning support. All students in our school system must take the test in person in the enrolled schools and must bring their Power Up 1:1 Technology Device.

High School students and those students enrolled in American Literature and Composition, Algebra C&C, Biology and U.S. History are required to complete an end of course test (see table below). This year, Georgia Milestones end-of-course tests will count 10% towards a student's final grade in the class. Students who do not take the Georgia Milestones End-of-Course test will receive a zero or "incomplete" for that portion of their overall grade.

Your child will use their PowerUp Technology Device for testing. On testing days, please make sure that your child does the following:
