Awards Night and Recognition Ceremony

Please make plans to attend this special awards ceremony and please dress appropriately.

Graduation Practice

It is mandatory for every senior who has met **all** graduation requirements to meet promptly at in the gym at **8:15 a.m**. on Friday morning, **May 24th** as well as Tuesday, **May 28th** and Wednesday, **May 29th.** If you plan to participate in graduation exercises, **you must attend practice!** Young ladies are advised to bring the shoes they plan to wear at graduation so they can practice in them.

Graduation Ceremony

James Brown Arena no later than 8:30 a.m., Thursday morning, May 30th for line up. Please enter down the ramp on the backside (facing the post office). Graduation exercises will begin promptly at 10:00 a.m.

Graduation Restrictions

Please remind family and friends that balloons are not allowed in the arena and absolutely no NOISE making devices (horns, cow bells, etc..). Family members are NOT allowed on the floor prior, during or after the ceremony. Family and friends must meet you after the ceremony, in the front of the James Brown Arena.

Dress for Graduation

Young Men: Under robes, wear white dress shirts, black dress pants, and dark ties. (Black dress shoes) *Young Ladies:* Under robes, wear black dresses and black dress shoes. Dresses should not be longer than robes.

No spike heels (Stelettos), flip-flops, tennis shoes, sandals, sunglasses, no facial jewelry, jeans, or gum ***Do not write on or place pictures on the top of your mortarboard hat or any part of your graduation attire*** ***Only school issued regalia is allowed***

Keep cell phones off and out of sight

There will be no one to carry, hold or watch purses, please do not bring them

After Graduation

Graduates will report to the tunnel hall after the recessional to receive their diploma envelope.

Senior Fines & Credit Recovery
