Dear Parents,

The exam schedule for this year is printed below. Please note that the last day for <u>all</u> Middle and High School Students at Richmond County Technical Career Magnet School (RCTCM) is May 23<sup>rd</sup>. Car Riders will be dismissed at 12:15 on May 23<sup>rd</sup>. Bus Riders will remain in class with their Homeroom Teachers until the bus arrives.

No students will be released from class during an exam period. Once the exam period begins, students will remain in their testing sites until dismissed. Students who do not drive will not be allowed to leave campus <u>unless an adult is</u> <u>present to sign them out</u>; students who do drive MUST have written permission from a parent or legal guardian to leave early.

If a student exempts the morning exam only, the student should report to school by 11:05. If the student exempts the afternoon exam only, the student will be allowed to leave campus with written permission from a parent or legal guardian once the exam period ends at 11:05. Again, no students are allowed to leave the testing site until the exam period ends. This signed letter of parental consent must be presented no later than arrival to school on Exam day.

**Exemption Policy** - Final Exams will count for 20% of the overall grade for all high school courses. Georgia Milestone Assessments and other state mandated assessments may not be exempted. **Middle School Students are not eligible to exempt finals.** Final Exams for students in grades 9 -12 may exempt if the following requirements are met:

- a. 90% average or above in the course.
- b. No more than 6 absences for a year-long course and no more than 3 absences for a semester course.
