COACH'S CORNER---WHAT WE ARE LEARNING IN SCHOOL!

KINDERGARTEN MATH & READING

Students should know and be able to:

- Compare groups of objects using words "greater than," "less than," or "equal to"
- Compare numbers 1-10 written as numerals
- Describe and compare objects using length, width, weight, and height

2ND GRADE MATH & READING

- Measure the length of objects and compare objects lengths
- Estimate length using inches, feet, centimeters, and meters
- Solve word problems using lengths that are given in the same units
- Use measurements to make a line plot
- Represent lengths on a number line
- Tell time to the nearest 5 minutes when looking at analog and digital clocks
- Write time to the nearest 5 minutes using a.m. and p.m.

- Solve word problems involving multiplication of a fraction by a whole number Put together and take apart fractions using addition and subtraction
