Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

We are very proud of our teachers at Sue Reynolds. We feel they are ready for this school year and are prepared to help your child do their best in school. As a Title I school, we are required by federal law, the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA), to inform you of the qualifications of your child's teacher. It is your right to request the following information about your child's teacher as it relates to their training and credentials:

- Whether the teacher met the state requirements for the Georgia Professional Standards Commission for certification for the grade level and subject area they teach;
- Whether the teacher is teaching under any emergency or temporary status through which Georgia qualifications or certification criteria have been waived;
- The undergraduate or graduate degree(s) the teacher holds, including graduate certificates and additional degrees, and major(s) or area(s) of concentration; and
- Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, their qualifications.

Please know our staff is committed to helping your child reach his or her highest academic potential through their school career. This commitment includes making sure that all of our teachers and paraprofessionals are highly skilled and are providing quality instruction for your child.
