## LANGFORD MIDDLE SCHOOL

## Langford Narrative:

- The Phase VI program for Langford calls for the regeneration of the school by demolishing the existing buildings on campus with the exception of the 11classroom wing that was completed in 2015.
- The remainder of the buildings will be replaced in a 2-phase approach to allow for the campus to remain open throughout the regeneration process.
- The initial phase of the regeneration is budgeted at \$16.8 Million, which is included as a primary project in the Phase VI Program.
- The second phase of the regeneration process is budgeted at \$14.2Million and is a contingency project in the Phase VI Program.
- Which spaces will be regenerated in each phase will be determined based on the design of the new facility and the placement of the new facility on the school site.
- At the completion of the regeneration process Langford MS would have a capacity of 800 students. At the completion of the regeneration process, the school will have all new facilities (including the recently completed addition) and a new inviting look and sense of arrival to the facility.
