

# LANGFORD MIDDLE SCHOOL

## Langford Narrative:

- The Phase VI program for Langford calls for the regeneration of the school by demolishing the existing buildings on campus with the exception of the 11-classroom wing that was completed in 2015.
- The remainder of the buildings will be replaced in a 2-phase approach to allow for the campus to remain open throughout the regeneration process.
- The initial phase of the regeneration is budgeted at \$16.8 Million, which is included as a primary project in the Phase VI Program.
- The second phase of the regeneration process is budgeted at \$14.2 Million and is a contingency project in the Phase VI Program.
- Which spaces will be regenerated in each phase will be determined based on the design of the new facility and the placement of the new facility on the school site.
- At the completion of the regeneration process Langford MS would have a capacity of 800 students. At the completion of the regeneration process, the school will have all new facilities (including the recently completed addition) and a new inviting look and sense of arrival to the facility.
