

Community Coaches

I,	, understand that my work
as a community coach with the Richmond (County School System is an on-
call, as needed basis and I am not guaranteed work on a regular basis.	
Employee absences are unpredictable so we cannot forecast how many days a community coach will work a week or a school year. The Georgia Court of Appeals has determined that substitute/community coaches are not eligible for unemployment. [Campbell v. Poythress, 216 Ga. App. 834 (456 SE2d 110) 1995].	
I understand that to remain on the ACTIVE community coach list, I must coach a sport during the school year and I must pre-register every school year during the month of May by contacting the Athletic Director at the school and filling out/returning the GCIC form (Georgia Criminal Investigation Commission). I know that there is not a charge for the state background check.	
Furthermore, I understand that substitutes/community coaches are not eligible for unemployment when school is out for holidays and summer months and that there are no benefits associated with community coaching employment.
