RESILIENCE - The capacity to successfully manage high levels of change

December 12	Self-Confidence	Positive attitude about, and trust in one's self; sense of security and self assurance
January 9	Flexibility	Quality of showing adaptability and versatility
January 16	Diligence	Consistent attention to quality work; remaining focused on your goal
January 23	Initiative	Proactive; thinking and taking action n your own

TOLERANCE - Respecting the individual differenced, views, and belief of other people

February 6	Acceptance	Recognition of the diversity of others, their opinion, practices, and culture
