Georgia's Public Education Employee Assistance Program is now available to all PreK-12 teachers and K-12 employees who work 29 hours a week in Richmond County School System. That means you have free, confidential access to experienced mental health professionals, attorneys, financial specialists, work-life experts and much more. They are here for you any day, any time when you're facing issues that interfere with your health, well-being and productivity at home or at work.

The Employee Assistance Program (EAP) through the Georgia Department of Education is here to help you with the demands of life. All (Richmond County School System) PreK-12 teachers and K-12 employees who work at least 29 hours a week have access to highly qualified counselors who can offer up to six counseling sessions at no cost to you. Your counselor may refer you to resources in your community for ongoing support.
