Greetings Bulldog Family,

Our community has been impacted by a significant increase in COVID-19 cases. Based on current data and advice from a panel of local medical professionals, public health agencies, and hospital administrators, the Richmond County School System will proceed with the following changes for returning to school for 2nd Semester:

- All virtual students will begin instruction on Tuesday, January 12, 2021. Online teachers are calling now to facilitate online orientation! Meeting links are also available on our school web page.
- All Face to Face students will begin Learn@Home instruction on Thursday, January 14, 2021. Teachers will support Face to Face student learning each day! Be sure to check the teacher's class page for the designated time and meeting link.
- Learn@Home packets will be available for pickup in the lunchroom on Monday, January 11, 2021 – Wednesday, January 13, 2021 from 9:00AM-3:00PM. Packets also have been uploaded to each teacher's class page.
- A Virtual Open House will be available via Richmond Hill K-8 school webpage beginning on Monday, January 11, 2021.
- RCSS students in K-8, middle and high schools will tentatively allow Face to Face students to return to the building for instruction on Tuesday, January 26, 2021 pending further advisement from public health agencies.
- Students will be considered present for the entirety of the Learn@Home period as long as all assignments are completed.

Report Cards: Report Cards will be available for pickup Monday, January 11, 2021 – Wednesday, January 13, 2021 from 9:00AM – 3:00PM. Remaining report cards will be mailed from Richmond Hill K-8 to the primary address on file in Infinite Campus on Thursday, January 14, 2021. Report Cards will only be released to parents/guardians. If you would like to view your report card online, you may use Infinite Campus.
