Setting Groups in Edmodo to Moderate

As students are instructed on the use of Edmodo, they should be reminded that this is an extension of the classroom. The same expectations for behavior and quality of work apply to this environment. In the event that a student does not follow the rules and decides to post something of questionable content, Groups set to Moderate allow the teacher to prevent anything showing up on the site that shouldn't be there.
