Dear Parents.

Beginning the week of August 12, 2018 the fourth grade team of teaches will be implementing a behavior policy in an effort to promote positive behavior within the classroom. Please read the following information below as it applies to your child's weekly conduct grade.

Conduct Grade:

Each week you child will be assigned a conduct grade. How the grade is determined depends on your child's behavior for that particular week. At the beginning of each week, your child starts off with a conduct grade of 100%. Each time your child is signed in (by any of his or her 2 teachers), 5 points will be deducted from his or her conduct grade. The teachers will send home "Tuesday Folders" and the conduct grade listed is the conduct grade from the <u>previous week</u>.

What can your child be signed in for?

Sign-ins are, but not limited to: talking during instruction, inappropriate hallway behavior, constant disruptions, being disrespectful, and not being prepared for the school day. The purpose of the conduct sheet is to make parents aware of any inappropriate behavior in an effort to mediate the problem before a student is written up or suspended for said behavior. We **STRONGLY** advise parents to take the conduct grade seriously so that teachers and parents can work together to stop any disruptions to learning.

Tuesday Folder

Tuesday folders will be sent home every Tuesday unless otherwise noted. If the team of teachers decide to forgo sending home Tuesday folders, the parents will be notified in written form. Please do not accept the word of the student when he or she says, "I didn't get a Tuesday folder this week!" <u>Please sign the folder every Tuesday to aware teachers that you have seen the report for the week.</u>
