School and Community

Bayvale Elementary School is proudly centered in the community for which it was named. Bayvale is a public, inner-city elementary school established in 1926. On April 27, 1963 a fire broke out in the Northeast corner of the school and after battling the blaze only a wing of the school could be saved. A new school was erected to replace the one lost to the fire. The school is still committed to meeting the needs of students who live in the Bayvale Community. Bayvale Elementary School is a part of the Richmond County School System (RCSS), located in Augusta, Georgia, which operates 58 schools and serves more than 30,000 students.

General Information

Bayvale offers an English to the Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) program to meet the needs of its students. The purpose of the ESOL/Title III Program is to enable students to become competent in standards-based curriculum emphasizing academic and social language development. Also, the program is intended to help English Learners (EL) master the Georgia Performance Standards (GPS), the Common Core Georgia Performance Standards (CCGPS) and World-Class Instructional Design and Assessment (WIDA) Language Standards. Bayvale's Flexible Learning Program (FLP) addresses Mathematics and Reading through research-based strategies such as high-interest texts and leveled math and reading interventions aligned with the Common Core Curriculum. Bayvale's FLP adheres to the grade specific career awareness activities listed as an indicator on the College and Career Ready Performance Index to assist identified students and their families with career awareness; thereby purposefully attempting to increase the graduation rate of our students struggling to meet academic standards. The goal of the Reading Mentor's Program of the Governor's Office of Student Achievement (GOSA) is to have all children reading on grade level by the end of third grade. This initiative focuses on reading instruction and assessment for kindergarten through third grade students. Support is provided to teachers through an on-site Language and Literacy Specialist and the school's Academic Support Specialist.

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
