School and Community

Lamar Milledge Elementary School is nestled in the downtown community of Harrisburg. We are very fortunate to have ongoing and dedicated support from a number of community partners who tutor, donate book bags, clothing and various supplies, mentor and provide services that benefit not only the students, but aid the parents and community as well. Our school is named for Joseph Lamar former Supreme Court Justice and John Milledge former Governor of Georgia. World famous students who have attended our school include – Brenda Lee (Recording Artist) and Vernon Forest (Former WBC Welterweight Champion).

General Information

We follow the Georgia Common Core Standards and Frameworks. Our special programs include the Governor’s Office of Student Achievement Literacy Grant which focuses on Grades K-3, Art Infusion for Grades 4 & 5, Summer School Program, and WRITING TO WIN for Grades K-5.

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia’s statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
