## School and Community

Tobacco Road Elementary School is located 11.7 miles from downtown Augusta, Ga. Augusta is known as the home of The Masters golf tournament and the home of the Godfather of Soul, James Brown. City attractions include the James Brown Arena, Augusta Canal Interpretive Center, and Lucy C. Craft Laney Museum. Tobacco Road Elementary is located in the southeastern part of Augusta in Richmond County. The school's doors were first opened in August of 1993. Students at Tobacco Road attend Seago and Pine Hill for middle school and Cross Creek and Butler for high school.

## General Information

Tobacco Road Elementary follows the Georgia Common Core Curriculum Standards. Our goals are to prepare our students to be College and Career ready by providing them with rigorous material and holding them to high expectations. Our curriculum consists of Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and Writing. In addition, we provide our students with numerous hands on learning experiences in our Computer Lab, Science Lab, and via Educational Field Trips. We also offer courses in Business and Computer Science, Music, Physical Education, and Gifted Education. Our school incorporates technology into daily instruction through the use of Computer Literacy classes, desktop computers, laptop carts, Promethean Boards, and Actiview Cameras. Tobacco Road is one of ten pilot schools in the district that will incorporate the Positive Behavior Intervention Program this year. Tobacco Road has entered into a unique partnership with HealthMPowers to promote healthy behaviors by empowering students, school staff and families to improve health and academic achievement.

## College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
