School and Community

The highly qualified and committed staff of Craig–Houghton partners with families and communities to nurture meaningful relationships in order to provide a quality education for all children. Our goal is to foster independence, competence, problem-solving skills, the ability to work cooperatively within a group and follow the spark of intellectual inquisitiveness and mastery of academic skills kindled in their primary years. Craig Houghton has excellent community resources with a parent and community chat with the counselor. Students have access to a technology enriched environment, mentoring and in school tutoring. Craig Houghton is operated by RCSS which has 58 schools and serves over 30,000 students. RCSS has an International Baccalaureate Program, top-rated magnet schools and programs, specialized curricula such as STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics), Arts infusion, and technology rich classrooms.

General Information

The student population is made up of Pre-K– First Grade on the first floor, and second grade through fifth grade on the second floor. Students with disabilities along with speech and hearing, is on the first floor. Centrally located are the art, music, media center, guidance and the main office areas, which are grouped near the main entrance. A physical education/dining area is located on one end and acts as a community center. Natural daylight permeates throughout the building which creates a bright and lively atmosphere. Classrooms are equipped with a Promethean board and three computers.

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
