With the belief that we are armored in excellence, the staff, our partners in education and parents of Jamestown Elementary School are purposed to harvest the potential that each one of our students possess. We want to ensure that all students get a quality education, beginning with the end in mind. In addition, we support the district vision and mission as we serve students to help them all become lifelong learners and productive citizens. It is our sincere desire that we create a meaningful educational experience that ultimately leads to graduation from high school, with their peers, college and career ready. Furthermore we are purposed to serve our students so that they use the knowledge gained and further their education at an accredited college or university, yielding productive citizens that give back to their communities.

## General Information

At Jamestown Elementary School, the leaders, teachers, and staff support the implementation of the Richmond County's Rigorous Curriculum and Knowledge through 12. We also utilize research based instructional practices (school wide) as a platform to positively increase student achievement. These instructional practices include personalized learning ,Writing to Win, AVID WICOR Strategies, and Teach Like A Champion instructional and cultural practices. JES is proud of the academic support that we provide our students. Other special programs include the National Junior Beta Club, Science Technology Engineering Mathematics (STEM) Team, Music program, Beginning and intermediate Orchestra program, and a Math and Reading Team that competes annually in the Math competition and Helen Ruffin Reading Bowl.

## College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
