School and Community

Jenkins-White Elementary School is an accredited inner city school located on the industrial outskirts of Augusta, Richmond County, Georgia. It is located on 15th Avenue near the Medical College of Georgia and Paine College. Enrollment data reveals that JWES serves a severely at-risk student population compared to both the district and the state. The school serves students from three public housing developments. JWES has a student population of approximately 435 students prekindergarten to fifth grade that are supported by 63 faculty and staff. Jenkins White is located in Augusta, Georgia which is the second largest and oldest city in Georgia. Augusta is best known as the Garden City and home of the Masters Golf Tournament. RCSS operates 58 schools and serves over 30,000 students. RCSS has an International Baccalaureate Program, top-rated magnet schools and programs, specialized curricula such as STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics), Arts infusion, and technology rich classrooms.

General Information

Our students receive daily instruction using the Georgia Common Core Curriculum for English Language Arts and Math. Students also receive daily instruction using the Georgia Performance Standards for Science and Social Studies. We also provide our students with classes in Music, Art, Physical Education and Health. Our third through fifth grade students have the opportunity to participate in our 21st Century After-School Program were they can receive additional assistant with homework as well as various other interesting topics. Our JWES Dance Team receives instruction in classical and contemporary dance techniques and have city wide performances. Our fourth and fifth grade students have the opportunity to participate in our award winning JWES Chorus under the direction of Dr. Johnson-Porter, Richmond County Public Schools 2016 Teacher of the Year

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College Career and Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of collegeand career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
