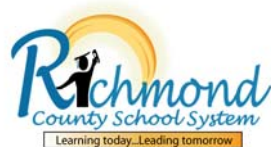

## 2016-2017 School Profile and Special Programs

Meadowbrook Elementary School opened its doors in service to the South Augusta community in 1978. Nestled in the Meadowbrook housing subdivision, Meadowbrook Elementary School prides itself in engaging, educating, and empowering students and stakeholders to reach their full potential through the development of meaningful relationships with families and the delivery of expert quality instruction each day. Meadowbrook Elementary School serves 520 students ranging from prekindergarten through fifth grade.

### General Information

Meadowbrook Elementary School offers a comprehensive program with an emphasis on literacy across the curriculum. Through a partnership with the Governor's Office of Student Achievement, kindergarten through third grade students receive additional literacy intervention alongside the required curriculum. Fourth and fifth grade students strategically develop higher order thinking skills in an effort to ensure they are college and career ready. Meadowbrook students are afforded extended learning opportunities that provide additional time, both during and outside the traditional school day, in order to adequately serve their needs. Meadowbrook Elementary School also has several partnerships with groups that provide support for students and teachers throughout the year.

### College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
