School and Community

Sue Reynolds Elementary School is named for the fine lady who worked tirelessly to build community support for the first school in this area. She also served as the leader and a teacher at that school for many years. She was truly a visionary and advocate for education. Ms. Reynolds would be proud to see the 3rd building with her namesake, serving over 900 students Pre K-5th grade. Our current campus was established 14 years ago, replacing a smaller building about 1 mile down Wrightsboro Road. In many cases we are serving 2nd generation Reynolds students, as many in our community attended school at the building down the road when they were children. We are proud to be the largest elementary school in the Richmond County School System (RCSS). Sue Reynolds is located in Augusta which is the second largest and oldest city in Georgia and is known as the Garden City and home of the Masters Golf Tournament. Sue Reynolds has one of the many STEM programs in our school district. Our staff, students, and school volunteers work hard each day to make sure Reynolds continues to be a great place to work and learn.

General Information

Sue Reynolds has 2 full time Pre K classes, offered as a lottery by Bright From The Start. We have many (5-7) classes in each grade kindergarten through fifth grade. All teachers use a variety of best-practice instructional strategies to enable students to demonstrate proficiency on Common Core Standards, to problem solve real life problems, to work collaboratively, and to learn to enjoy learning. We also have 4 STEM classes, one each in second through fifth grades. Students apply for our STEM team in the spring of each school year and remain on that team until moving on to middle school. In addition to our daily instructional program, we offer a variety of extracurricular experiences for our students. We have a fine arts club, focusing on dance, singing and drama. We have a morning news team, school safety team, student council, math team, track team, Helen Ruffin Reading Bowl team, STEM for kids club, peer mediators, Passport to Manhood, Paw Partners, and Cub Cadets. Sue Reynolds students are active participants with HealthMPowers, 4-H, and our local DARE program. We also have a great group of school volunteers who support many of our extracurricular activities and help keep our students engaged in healthy choices.

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI)

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in three main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
